The Vision and Mission of the college serve as the beacon light and focus directing all the co-ordinated activities of all the stakeholders involved.


#### Nature of Governance:

The management of the college is vested with the Governing Council and the same is spearheaded by its president. The routine administrative affairs of the college are administered by the Principal under the mentorship of the Secretary, the second-incommand at SNMV CAS.

Faculty meetings and committee meetings were well attended meticulously minuted. There was a complete absence of hierarchy - junior faculty could speak as freely as senior faculty. This gave faculty an enormous sense of ownership and pride in the institution and brought out the best in them.

Not limiting to the above, there was considerable mentoring of new faculty. Certain egalitarianism was part of the culture. All this was reinforced by a certain austerity. Alongside faculty governance, a strong peer culture developed.

The institution has constituted academic committees, IQAC, Academic Council, IIC etc. and signed MoUs with leading industry houses and institutions for bringing in excellence in higher education. The IQAC regularly meets and takes initiatives for the continuous improvement of the quality of the education.






