Inauguration of Women Empowerment Cell



Report - Webinar on "Psychiatric Social Work Practice" on 29.10.2021 @ 11.00 AM



During the session she discussed about the fundamentals and salient features of the laws pertaining IT Act, cyber cybercrime, Special Marriage Act 1954, The Dowry Prohibition Act 1961, Domestic Violence Act 2005, Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Act 2017, Medical Termination of Pregnancy (Amendment) Act 2021, Vishaka Guidelines, The Sexual harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013, which is commonly referred as POSH Act, types of sexual harassment at Workplace, Stalking and modes of stalking, child labour prohibition Act, Adoption and its procedures, Child Marriage Restraint Act, Protection of Child from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO), Right to free and compulsory education, Role of 1098, Transgender Protection of Rights Bill 2019, consumer laws and rights of consumers and Motor Vehicle Act 1988.

1st November 2021, session was held on the topic "Environment - Create Solution; Not Pollution".
