COLLEGE - Un-aided private Arts and Science College - Permission to open a co-educational college at Malurichampatti in Coimbatore Taluk and District - Order issued.

Annulment

In the G.O. first read above, the Government permitted the Coimbatore Mohru Association to start a co-educational college from the year 1988-89, on certain conditions. The college could not be started during 1988-89 since the Bharathiar University considered that it was too late to start the college. In the meantime, the Government have issued revised guidelines in the G.O. second read above. Now the Director of Collegiate Education in his letter third read above has forwarded the application of the Coimbatore Mohru Association, Robertson Road, Coimbatore to start an unaided private Arts and Science College named as Sri Mohru Maha Vidyalaya Arts and Science College at Malurichampatti village, Coimbatore. The Director of Collegiate Education has also stated that the Management has satisfied the revised conditions as follows:-

- 1) An endowment of Rs. 10.00 Lakhs (Rupees ten Lakhs only) in the joint names of the Director of Collegiate Education and the Educational Agency has been created in the Canara Bank, Coimbatore on 27.7.89
- 2) The Management has provided 50.30 acres of land in one compact block.
- 3) The Management has executed bond to abide by all the conditions including those relating to (a) admission of 50% of the students as per the choice of the Management and 50% as per the rules and reservations prescribed by Government; (b) Non-collection of capitation fee and donation from students; and (c) levy of tuition and other fees as prescribed for Government Colleges.

The Educational Agency have submitted plans for the construction of building in the site at Malurichampatti village within one year and till then the classes are to be accommodated in Mohru Vidyalaya Higher Secondary School, Coimbatore. The Director of Collegiate Education recommended for waiver of conducting classes in school campus.

2) The Government have examined the proposal carefully and permit the Coimbatore Welfare Association, Robertson Road, Coimbatore to start the Mahru Mahru Vidyalaya Arts and Science College (co-educational) at Malanchampatti village, Coimbatore from the year 1988-89 with the following courses of study:-

- 1) U.C. Computer Science.
- 2) B.B.A.
- 3) B.COM.

Subject to the following conditions:-

- i) The Government will not grant any financial assistance at any time for any reason.
- ii) The Management should satisfy all the conditions prescribed in the G.O. second read above.
- iii) Affiliation of the University concerned be obtained before the commencement of the courses of study.
- iv) No other courses except science courses and other courses allowed by the Government/University shall be conducted.
- v) The number of teaching and non-teaching staff to be appointed should be as per the prescribed yardstick and qualifications.
- vi) If the Management creates a situation causing the closure of the college for any reason, the Government will not come forward to take it over.

3) The Management is permitted as a special case to conduct the classes of the college in the Mahru Vidyalaya Higher Secondary School Campus, only temporarily, till the end of this academic year, and they should shift to new premises during next academic year.
